IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Academic levels offered: Undergraduate and Graduate.

Language of instruction: Most of our courses are offered in Spanish.

Language requirement: There is not a language certificate requirement in order to study in our university. However, we strongly recommend having, at least, a B1 level of **Spanish.** Otherwise, they may not be able to complete the courses successfully.

In our Campestre Campus we have student's **Residence Hall**, spaces are scarce so the application must be sent at least 3 or 4 months in advance.

Students can also rent a flat or a room nearby on their own responsibility.

<u>Visa requirement:</u> For most nationalities, there is a temporary permission to stay in Mexican territory for a period of 180 days **without** a Visa.

At the arrival to Mexican Territory, students must get their FMM format on-line inthe following linK:

This format is VERY IMPORTANT, because it is the temporary **official permit** to live in Mexico. For other Nationalities, it is necessary to apply for a student's Visa at the nearest Mexican Consulate or Embassy.

Do contact your nearest consulate to confirm that you don't require a visa, as this information could change.

Health insurance for international students:

It is a mandatory requirement to have it, and should cover the student's entire stay in the country and must include the repatriation of remains and civil liability. This document is essential to complete the enrollment when arriving at the university.
